BABY PROOFING



checklist

KITCHEN

Cupboard locks/clips on doors and draws that contain breakable sharp items Cupboard locks/clips on doors and draws that hold harmful items e.g. cleaning products, alcohol, and medicines. If possible move the above items to a storage cupboard high and out of reach, with a lock. ☐ Anchoring furniture that can be pulled over and tipped Appliance locks e.g. microwave, fridge, oven etc. Wrap dangling cords Cover electrical outlets Corner cushions for sharp edges of benches or tables ☐ If possible, a baby gate that barriers off access to the kitchen or pantry Remove small magnets (smaller than 20cent piece) from the fridge

LIVING SPACES

Anchoring or mounting T.V Wrapping electrical cords e.g T.V Draws or cabinets that require locks/clips Cover electrical outlets Corner cushions for sharp edges of furniture Anchoring furniture e.g bookshelves, tall lamps, hall tables, mirrors Removing hazardous items around the fireplace Baby safety gate around the fireplace, at the appropriate distance. Window locks, if the window opening is more than 12.5cm Blind cord wrapped Locks on doors leading to outside areas

STAIRCASE BATHROOMS Baby safety gates at the top and bottom Cabinet and draw locks/clips of stairs (avoid pressure gates at the top Move hazardous e.g. medicines, of stairs) nail polish, sanitiser, cleaning Handrails/balustrade openings of more items up high and locked away. ☐ Window locks for opening more than 12.5cm require covering than 12.5cm Toilet lock NURSERY LAUNDRY Furniture anchored Cot set up for safe sleep e.g no bumpers, Hazdous and poisonous toys, no low hanging mobiles products locked and out of Cupboard locks/clips on doors and reach, e.g cleaning products, draws medicine Baby supplies out of reach e.g wipes, Anchoring furniture creams, hand sanitiser Safe space for soaking clothes Electrical cords wrapped and secured in water filled buckets e.g baby monitors, sound machines WORK SPACES OTHER BEDROOMS Wrap and bundle electrical cords e.g Anchor furniture computer, chargers, printer ☐ Window openings of more than Cupboard locks/clips on doors and 12.5cm cupboards Wrap window cords ■ Baby safety gate to barrier off space if Wrap and bundle electrical cords needed
